### Parental survey results

February 2023

Following parent consultation evenings, a survey was shared with all parents. The event was attended by 92% of parents/carers (excluding Year 3 due to staff absence); letters have been sent to those who did not attend. The survey was completed via a Microsoft Form by 28.3% of the attendees. This capturing of feedback is supported by Parent Forum meeting outcomes and discussions which acts as another opportunity for parents and carers to voice their viewpoints and concerns.
