Home Learning Focus

Maths home learning will be completed via the **White Rose Maths Home Journals**. Children will be informed which pages they are expected to complete and when the work is due. Please support your child in keeping up with these tasks – they match the maths learning that is taking place in the classroom.

We expect children to record their reading in their diaries. Children should aim to complete a minimum of **three sessions of 15 minutes reading each week**. In addition, each child will be provided with a **CGP Reading Comprehension book** and will be expected to complete **one task per week**.

Home learning will be shared with the children towards the end of the week; completed work needs to be handed in by Wednesday of the following week; the expectation is that children do not spend longer than 30 minutes on each activity; if home learning is taking longer than this, please let us know and we will make any adaptations required.
